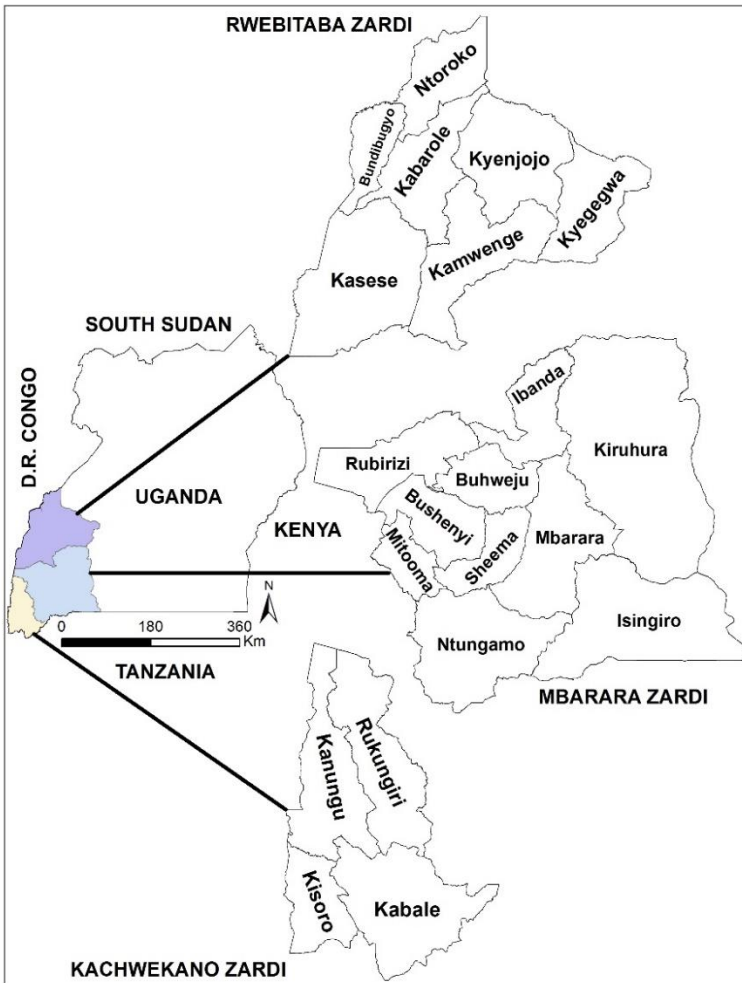


UNU-LRT TRAINING PROGRAMME

The United Nations Land Restoration Training Programme (UNU-LRT), the National Environment Management Authority (NEMA) and Makerere University, are organizing a training targeting local government officers working in **the environment and natural resources (ENR) and allied departments**. This is a domestic version of UNU-LRT's six months international training programme held every year in Iceland, and is intended to build the capacity of officers in the areas of **sustainable land use, land restoration and its interlinkages with climate change in Uganda**. **The training is fully funded by UNU-LRT, and will take place in Kasese Town, from 25th September to 3rd October, 2017**. The first intake will consider officers working in the districts that make up Mbarara, Kachwekano and Rwebitaba Zonal Agricultural Research Development Institutes (ZARDIs) – see figure below.
